

Soli Deo Gloria: To Glorify God and Enjoy Him Forever

*So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.  
1 Corinthians 10:31*

“The chief end of man is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever”- A Reformation Catechism.

**Glorify:** to display the person and presence of God.

**How well we glorify God in daily life is revealed in how we use our freedom in Christ.**

**1. The Good-of-my-neighbor question.** How does this use of my freedom in Christ benefit my neighbor?

*Let no one seek his own good, but the good of his neighbor, 10:24*

- Chapter 8
- Liberty/freedom in Christ- *All things are lawful, v. 23*
- The good of someone else- *not all things are helpful, v. 23*

**2.The Gospel question.** How does this use of my freedom in Christ help the non-believer become saved?

*Not seeking my own advantage but that of many, that they may be saved.  
10:33*

- Chapter 9
- *Not seeking my own advantage, v 33*
- **THAT THEY(the many)MAY BE SAVED.**

**3,The Glory question.** How does what I am doing reflect on the reputation of God?

*Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31*

- Vain, worthless idols, lesser glories
- Glory of God in my regular activities
- Reflection or Eclipse?

Whoever speaks, let him speak, as it were, the utterances of God; whoever serves, let him do it so as by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever.
